Scholarship Application Instructions

1. In memory of Ian Custodio's love of the game and competitive spirit, this application must be accompanied by a 300-word essay on "As a player born in 2005, What specific steps can I take to positively impact my local or greater soccer community?"
2. Scholarship awards will be based on the essay and will be assigned to one recipient each year as follows:
 - a.) Full scholarship: This award means that the family is responsible for none of the **program fee**. Deposit fee, travel costs and event fee(s) are not subject to scholarship. The player is expected to work to positively to impact the soccer community as described in the award recipient's essay in Ian's memory
3. Please review the 2019 ODP cost breakdown and explanation sheet that has been provided with this application. This sheet contains a breakdown and explanation of costs.
4. Scholarship applications may be sent to the state office starting November 16, 2018. Completed application, notification form and essay must reach the State office by **COB, December 7, 2018. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.** Submit all application materials to the following:

5. The scholarship committee consists of the MSYSA 2nd Vice President, MSYSA Programs Director, 1 Member at Large, 1 Regional Commissioner, and the MSYSA Treasurer.
6. The decision of the scholarship committee will be final. Notification to all applicants, regardless of outcome, will be sent by December 31, 2018.
7. MSYSA reserves the right to use all or part of the included essay for promotional purposes. These may include but are not limited to website, email, printed materials, video and social media platforms. All other family information and records will be destroyed after the current seasonal year.
8. All other information provided will be kept confidential and destroyed after the current season

Program Fee includes:

Costs not covered by Program Fee:

- International Trips (Approximate cost: \$3000)
- East Region Tournament (Rider Cup) (Approximate cost: \$150)
- Other Travel Expenses (Approximate cost varies)

Payment Policies:

- A \$25 fee will be added to all returned checks and credit cards. Additionally, once a returned payment fee has been incurred, all future ODP fees must be paid in cash, money order or certified check.
- MSYSA will enforce a strict "No Pay...No Play" policy for all ODP participants. If a player is not current with ODP fees then the player will not be allowed to participate in any ODP activities, including but not limited to training sessions, practice games, tournaments, and camps. The player will be allowed to rejoin the program after all owed fees are paid.
- No refunds will be processed for Maryland State ODP fees. Exceptions to this will be considered on a case by case basis.
