




ADDING PLAYERS TO YOUR EVENT ROSTER

Step One:

From your User Account, click the “Team Management” tab.



Step Three:

After you have entered the player information, click “Create” to add the player.



Importing Players Through GotSoccer Team API

To import your “GotSoccer Legacy” roster over to GotSport, you will need to click on “Team Management”. From there, click on the team you want to import and enter the “Legacy ID” shown in screen shot below. After entering the GotSoccer team ID, you will see an “Import From Legacy” button appear. Click “Import From Legacy”, then “Next”, and finally click “Import” to bring your players over.

*****Each player must have a unique email address in GotSoccer Legacy in order to successfully be imported through the team API *****

If you need help accessing your legacy GotSoccer team ID number, this may be found by logging into your GotSoccer Legacy team account in the top left corner or on the GotSoccer team rankings page.
