Qualifications:

- Minimum Education: High School Diploma or GED preferred
- Minimum Experience: Some sporting background, teaching/coaching is a plus but not required
- Must be at least 18 years old
- Access to reliable transportation
- Consent to and complete a background check (MSYSA will cover the cost)
- Competent in guiding the head coach with (25-35) students, ages 6-11, through sport and lifeteaching moments

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Attend one practice per week for a weekly commitment of approximately 1.5-2 hours (3:00pm-5:00pm – typical timeframe)
- Assist with the facilitation of the day’s lesson plan
- Participate in games and activities with the students
- Work with head coaches and volunteers to create a positive learning environment

Special Requirements
