DAY 1

Flight to Amsterdam

Leidseplein Explore a busy square at the southern end of Amsterdam's central canal ring. Leidseplein translates roughly as Leiden Square, as it sits at the end of Leidsestraat which, throughout much of the history of the square, was the main road to the town of Leiden.

Friendly Match We will play a Friendly Match against a local club or academy team. The team will meet and compete against athletes of similar ages and skill levels.
